



How do you clean your **garbage chutes**?

- Sometimes building staff will stick a pressure washer or garden hose inside the chute and spray where they can see leaving up to 2/3 of the chute unclean
- Some companies do not clean chutes because it is garbage, it is supposed to smell and tenants just have to deal with it
- Some will hire companies which will offer you 2 or 3 pricing levels, which means you get 2 or 3 different levels of cleaning

How does **TRIFLOW** clean chutes?

To begin, we only provide a thorough cleaning service. We clean from the top floor to the bottom of the chute, inside the compactor and all the bins all at one price. Here is a basic process of what we do:

1. The chute, bins and compactor are treated with a hospital grade germicide to kill germs, viruses, bacteria, mould and mildew
2. Blast the chute walls from top floor to bottom (this kills eggs and nests of roaches)
3. Apply an odor counteracting agent to eliminate odors
4. Blast dumpsters and compactor
5. Apply the same germicide and odor neutralizer to every garbage room floor, walls and handles
